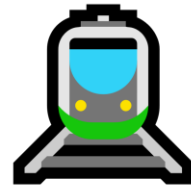

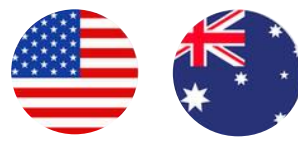

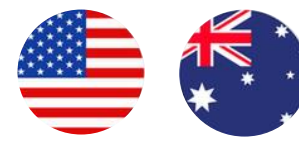

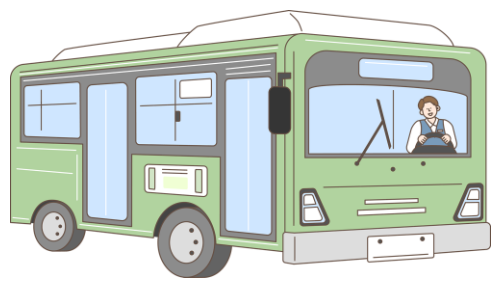

Part B: Which Do You Prefer?

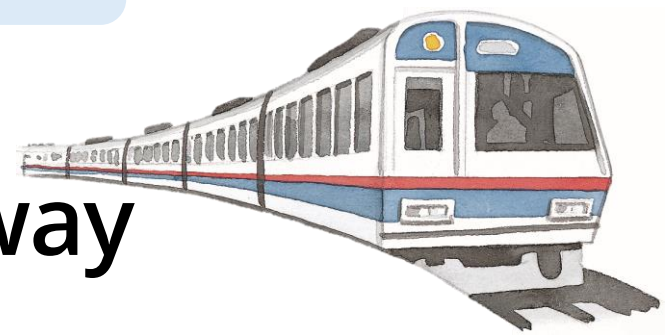
Q. Which do you prefer for commuting, and why?

Useful Vocab:

Commute (통근하다)

To travel regularly between home and work/school.

"I commute to work by train every day."

Peak hours (붐비는 시간)

The busiest times of the day.

"Buses are always crowded during peak hours."

Night rider (심야버스)

Buses that run late night or overnight.

"Many workers finishing late shifts uses night riders."

Useful Expressions:

"What's the most convenient way to get there?"

Used when asking for the best mode of transport.

"I prefer (A) over (B) because..."

Used to compare two transport options and explain a preference.
