For the first time in over 50 years, Congress **held a hearing** on UFOs. Two top U.S. defense intelligence officials said on Tuesday the Pentagon **is committed to** determining the **origins** of what the government calls "unidentified aerial phenomena" or UAP, and said they would follow the data wherever it leads them. "We have our questions. We want to know what's out there as much as you want to know what's out there." The two officials, Ronald Moultrie and Scott Bray, appeared before a House intelligence **subcommittee** 11 months after a report documenting more than 140 cases of UAPs that U.S. military pilots have reported observing since 2004. Officials on Tuesday showed two examples of such **encounters** - in one, flying glowing triangles fill the sky. After analysis, Bray said it was determined they were just drones. "We're now reasonably confident that these triangles correlate to unmanned aerial systems in the area. The triangular appearance is a result of light passing through the nightvision goggles and then passing through an SLR camera." The second video - of an orb quickly flashing across the screen - was an instance of a sighting that U.S. officials "can't explain." "I do not have an explanation for what this specific object is." "When I say unexplained, I mean everything from too little, too little data to we simply the data that we have doesn't point us towards an explanation, but we'll go wherever the data takes us. Again, we make no assumptions on what this is or isn't." Last year's report and Tuesday's hearing marked a **turning point** for the U.S. government after decades spent deflecting, **debunking** and **discrediting** observations of **unidentified flying objects** and "flying saucers" **dating back to** the 1940s. But beyond the science fiction implications, officials expressed concern over possible air safety and national security threats - especially if these phenomena were evidence of superior technology among foreign adversaries. According to that report, further data and analysis were needed.
